Pets are family so it's important that we do everything we can to keep them safe. That's why pet licensing is so important! When lost pets end up in shelters, those with licence tags get home faster. In Newmarket, all dogs, and cats over the age of 16 weeks must have a license. Once you license your pet, you can:

- Add information to your pet's profile
- Edit key information if it changes
- Upload a photo of your pet
- Report if your pet is lost
